



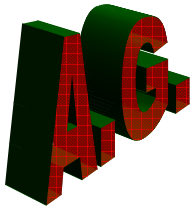

## White Tee Markers

## Nearest The Pin Markers

Members, please leave nearest the pin markers on the green at all times. If you are close to the hole, place the marker directly behind the hole at the same distance. We will in due course have some flat nearest the pin markers available.
