## Thankyou

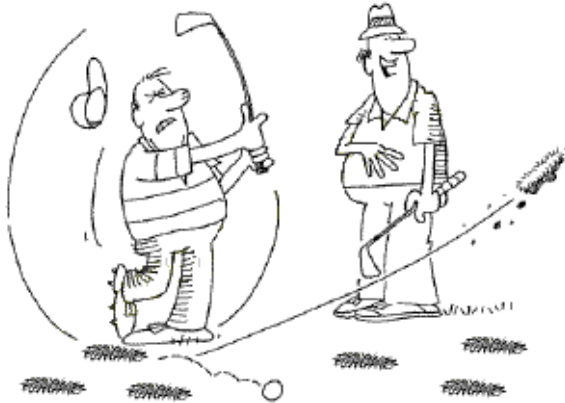

## Royal Fremantle Visit

Members are reminded that a bus trip to RFGC is set for the weekend of Sat/Sun 11/12<sup>th</sup> October 2008. ## Divots



How about you repair your divot and the others left by other players as well !!!!

The divots appear to be getting worse on the course, especially at the corner on the 11<sup>th</sup>, which is a disgrace. Taking care of the golf course is your responsibility while you are playing a round of golf. What you do or don't do will greatly affect the players immediately behind you, as well as the membership as a whole. The golf course is a living

breathing thing that requires cooperation on your part to help keep it in the best possible condition. So let's fix as many divots we can the next time we play.

## Know The Rules

### WATER HAZARDS

A ball is in a water hazard when any part is inside the margin of the hazard. Stakes defining a hazard are obstructions "within the hazard". If a ball is lost within a water hazard, or the player chooses not to play the ball as it lies, options are, (for 1 stroke penalty):

- (1) drop a ball behind the hazard (no limit on distance), at a point in line with where the ball last entered the hazard and the flag.
- (2) go back, and play from where the previous shot was played.

x = Entry Point

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### LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Red Markers)

If the hazard is a "Lateral Water Hazard," (defined by red markers) 2 further options are available. Drop within 2 club lengths of:

- (3) the point where the ball last entered the hazard not nearer the hole. If it is not possible to drop within 2 club lengths without being nearer the hole this option is lost.
- (4) a point on the opposite side of the hazard - opposite to the point where the hazard was last crossed equidistant from the hole.

x = Entry Point

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### BALL MOVES WHEN ADDRESSED

I touched my ball when I started to address it but it rolled back to where it was.

That's fortunate Russell. There's no penalty for accidentally touching the ball if it doesn't move or if it rolls back.

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### BALL MOVED

I've driven over your ball Doug. As we are sharing this cart that means a penalty for you.

Not so Russell. As you were moving the cart without me, all equipment on the cart is deemed to be yours, so no penalty is incurred.

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### BALL MOVES

I thought that ball was going to roll so I've withdrawn and will wait 'till the wind stops.

You're wasting your time Russell. You addressed the ball so if it now rolls you have a 1 stroke penalty. It matters not that you are nowhere near it when it subsequently rolls. If you were on the green, marking the ball would avoid penalty, but as you are not you better move quickly.

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### BALL MOVED

Oops! I've stood on my ball and it's now stuck in the ground. I couldn't see it in the rough area.

Well unfortunately that's a 1 stroke penalty Russell. The ball can be placed in the most similar position to what it was before you stood on it, within 1 club length (not nearer the hole or in a hazard).

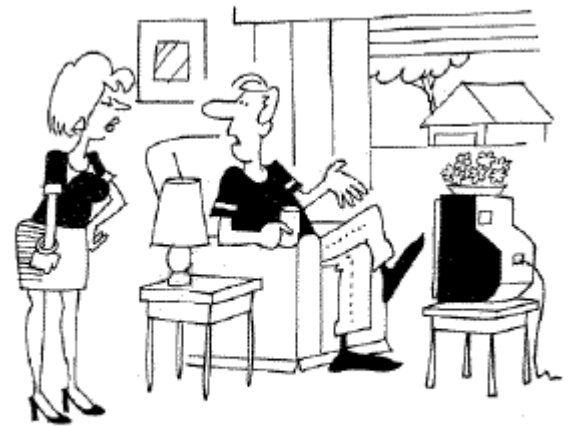
